

CONDITION OF HIGH VISIBILITY CLOTHING.

SAFETY INFORMATION

High-visibility clothing is worn to alert drivers and other vehicle/plant operators of a workers presence, especially in the dark, low light and adverse weather conditions.

High-visibility clothing allows you to be seen by the driver of the vehicle sooner and more readily. This fact increases your **SAFETY**.



The operative to the right in the picture on the left is not visible at 53 metres. Therefore not giving the driver of the vehicle enough time to stop at 50mph.

ACTIONS REQUIRED

- Operatives are to check high visibility clothing prior to every shift.
- Making sure all reflective tape is intact.
- If the clothing is heavily soiled clean or replace.
