A traffic marshal slipped on a crossing slab when opening the gates for the haul road at the start of the shift.

Injured Person (IP) taken to A&E and confirmed a closed hairline fracture to their right wrist.

What we know

- The IP was opening the gates at the start of the shift.
- There were no supervisor checks of the work area before sending IP out to work.
- There was heavy rain the night before and freezing temperatures overnight.
- The area was not gritted the night before.

Actions taken

- A tractor spreader attachment is now available to spread grit over haul road crossings.
- The crossing points are now gritted prior to freezing temperatures.
